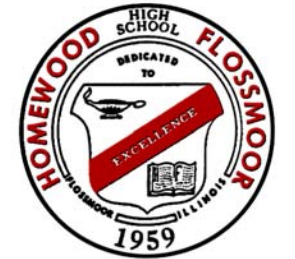

THE SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY:

Homewood-Flossmoor Community High School is located in the south suburbs of Chicago. The school is proud to maintain a reputation for academic excellence within a diverse environment. H-F serves all or portions of the following communities: Homewood, Flossmoor, Olympia Fields, Glenwood, Hazel Crest and Chicago Heights.

In 2002, Homewood-Flossmoor High School was named, for the third time, a U.S. Department of Education Blue Ribbon Award winner – one of only twenty-five high schools nationwide sharing this honor. Among other recent recognitions, H-F is a two-time winner of the Department of Education's Technology Award; *Newsweek Magazine* ranked H-F as one of the top 2% of public high schools in the nation; and H-F has been named a top-ranked school by *SchoolMatch* for 15 consecutive years. The school is accredited by the North Central Association.

THE STUDENTS 2008-2009:

Enrollment for 2009-2010 is approximately 3000. The educational experience is enhanced by a diverse community of learners; 39% White, 52% Black, 5% Hispanic, 2% Asian American, 2% Multiracial. H-F's daily attendance is 92%. The graduation rate is 97%. Students are involved in more than 100 clubs and activities and can participate in 28 varsity sports.

The Class of 2010 includes: 1 National Merit Semi-finalist (8 Commended) and 5 National Achievement Semi-finalists

Special recognitions garnered by H-F students in recent years include: Tandy Scholar, Coca-Cola Scholar, numerous Chicago Tribune All-Academic team members, National Silver Gloves Champion, First Place state recognitions for Group Interpretation and Contest Play; World-wide Youth in Science and Engineering tournament gold and silver medalists; National DECA Quiz Bowl qualifiers; National Skills USA qualifiers. IHSA Sectional Journalism Second Place winners for Yearbook and the Voyager newspaper; EDDA, the art and literary magazine was awarded a Gold Medal by Columbia Scholastic Press Association.

H-F currently has 175 faculty members with an average teaching experience of ten years. The faculty's dedication to maintaining an excellent student success rate these past years can be seen in their following recognitions: INROADS Educator of the Year, Coca-Cola Educator of Distinction, Lawrence Scadden Teacher of the Year Award in Science Education for Students with Disabilities, Illinois Business Association's Outstanding New Professional, Illinois Association of College Admission Counseling, President's Service Leadership Award, Golden Apple winners, Illinois High School Boys Gymnastics Coach Hall of Fame, and an All-State Director for the Illinois High School Theatre Festival.

THE CURRICULUM:

Homewood-Flossmoor High School offers a strong college preparatory program. Graduation requirements include four years of English, three years of Social Sciences, three years of Mathematics, three years of Science, and four years of Physical Education. Average class size is 19. A gifted program offers enrichment opportunities to approximately 200 students. H-F operates on a flexible "block" schedule. Classes meet twice a week in regular 50 minute periods and three times a week in 80 minute blocks.
