

After completing (and passing) both classroom and Behind-The-Wheel phases of Driver Education at HF

If you have taken both classroom and behind-the-wheel at H-F, YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A BLUE SLIP. This information is now being processed electronically. This should be complete approximately 7 to 10 business days after your final exams.

To check to see if your information has been processed and you are ready to get your license, check the following website:

- Go to www.isbe.state.il.us/
- Click on "Students"
- Scroll down and click on "Driver Education Student License Inquiry"
- Enter your permit number and click on "Search"
- If it says "Invalid instruction permit number," your information has not been processed yet. Check back in a few business days. If it is more than 3 weeks after final exams, check back with your classroom teacher.

After you are 16 years of age and your information has been processed, you may obtain your driver's license by taking the following to the Department of Motor Vehicles:

- 1) original Birth Certificate (must have official stamp or seal)
- 2) Social Security card
- 3) School or State I.D.
- 4) Learner's Permit (**must be held for a minimum 9 months**)
- 5) Completed 50-hour certification letter (time driven with parents)
- 6) Parent or legal guardian
- 7) A vehicle for driving test (must be licensed and properly equipped and you will need to provide proof of insurance)

Your driving test at the DMV may include any or all of the following:

- 1) residential driving
- 2) turns
- 3) stop signs and stop lights
- 4) hill parking
- 5) backing
- 6) turnabouts (including 3 pt. turn)
- 7) perpendicular or angle parking
