

PRE-COLLEGE RESEARCH PARTICIPATION PROGRAM

Program: An eight-week program in which college-bound students participate in laboratory research under the direction of Argonne scientists and engineers. Students will be selected by Argonne scientists and engineers who will provide for research experiences in areas such as Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Engineering, Energy, Conservation, Environmental Impact and Technology, Materials Science, Mathematics, Nanomaterials, Advanced Nuclear Energy Systems, and Physics.

Eligibility: Applicants must be 18 years of age at start of program; have a grade point average of at least 3.75 on a 4.0 scale; be a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident; will have graduated from a local Illinois high school in May/June 2011 and are enrolled to attend college full-time in Fall 2011.

Support: Stipend - \$400.00 per week

Program Dates: June 13, 2011 to August 5, 2011

Program Hours: Monday through Friday; 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
