I. Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors

I understand that on behalf of my son, daughter, or ward that all registration fees are due by the start of the school year, and any other fees are due when incurred.

I understand that if this financial obligation is not paid in full, according to School Board Policy 6725, my student, son, daughter or ward, will not be allowed to participate in the homecoming dance, turnabout dance or prom.

Fees and balances can be accessed at any time through the Parent Portal in PowerSchool. Outstanding charges can be paid in full or on a pre-approved payment plan through a secure online website, also accessed through the PowerSchool payment portal.

All financial obligations must be paid by September 1, 2021 in order for your student to be allowed to participate in the homecoming dance or by February 1, 2022, in order for your student to participate in the turnabout dance or prom.

II. <u>Seniors</u> – Seniors who fail to pay all fines in full will not be allowed to participate in graduation.

III. <u>Parental Obligation</u> - I understand that ALL unpaid financial obligations must be **paid in full** before the end of the 2021-2022 school year. If payment in full is not received by the last day of student attendance during the 2021-2022 school year, the balance will be transferred to our collection agency: Regional Recovery Services, Inc., which in turn will be forwarded to all credit score reporting agencies including **TransUnion**, **Equifax** and **Experian**.

I hereby confirm, that I have an understanding of my unpaid financial obligation, and fully understand the outcome as stated in Board Policy 6725 should the financial obligation not be paid in full by/at the conclusion of the current school year.
