



Student Checklist

What makes a completed application?

Generally, schools require the following:

- ✓ Completed application and application fee
- ✓ Official ACT/SAT/AP Scores
- ✓ Official High School Transcript

IF REQUIRED:

- ✓ Teacher Letters of Recommendation
- ✓ Counselor Letter of Recommendation
- ✓ Counselor Form/Signature Page
- ✓ Supplemental material (i.e. art work, writing sample, portfolio, etc.)
- ** All counselor evaluations (signature pages and letters of rec.) must be sent out of our office as they <u>will not</u> be handed back to students (may also apply for teachers)

- Register for ACT/SAT

 - Most colleges have continued to remain test optional; <u>FairTest</u> website
- Narrow down schools
- Begin filling out applications
- Meet with college reps
- Research your college choices



Timetable October



- FAFSA Time!!
- Take ACT/SAT
- Complete
 applications/turn in
 necessary supplemental
 forms to Registrar
- Attend college fair
- Meet with college reps
- Arrange off campus tours; Visit

Timetable November

- Note all application deadlines
- Meet with college reps
- Visit
- Keep grades up!



Deadlines!!!

Counselors are given 10 school days to process and send out supplemental materials...

... SO PLAN ACCORDINGLY!

- Be aware of application deadlines
- Those with **Jan. 1** deadlines need to be submitted to the registrar no later than **Friday**, **Dec. 10**
- Examples of Priority Deadlines (Early Action)
 - U of I (Urbana-Champaign) Nov. 1
 - STRONGLY encourage applying by EA deadline

NIU / DePaul Nov. 15

• SIUC / SIUE Dec. 1
