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Background

Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Incorporated was founded on November 12, 1922, on the campus of Butler University in Indianapolis, Indiana. The sorority, which is the only one of the four National Pan-Hellenic Council sororities started on a predominantly white college campus, was chartered by seven school teachers who were determined to create an organization of women who were committed to higher education, dedicated to youth, living by the highest ethical standards, and rendering unselfish service to make a better society.

On August 16, 1992, forty-six women chartered Eta Xi Sigma Alumnae Chapter in Oak Lawn, Illinois, one of the largest graduate chapters in Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority's history. As their numbers grew, they saw a need to further their Founders' dream of achievement through higher education, and thus, expanded their services in the community through the awarding of college scholarships to highly talented and deserving graduating high school seniors. Scholarship recipients will be identified as an **Eta Xi Sigma Scholar** and honored at our annual Pre-Mother's Day Rhomeania Event.

Eligibility...

The Beacon of Light Foundation of Eta Xi Sigma Alumnae Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Inc. provides scholarships to students of African American/Black descent of all genders to assist them with obtaining a bachelor's degree from a four-year college/university. An Eta Xi Sigma Scholar will typically demonstrate the following: **academic talent (20%); excellent writing skills and a desire to pursue a professional career (40%); and, strong leadership ability through a balance of honors and awards (10%), extracurricular activities and community service (20%), and recommendations regarding accomplishments (10%).**

Applicants are:

- African American/Black high school seniors who plan to attend a 4-year college/university in the Fall.
- **OR** An undergraduate member of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc., and member of Omicron Beta Chapter (UIC) or Xi Lambda Chapter (DePaul University).
- Permanent residents of the Chicago metropolitan area
- Students who possess a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (unweighted)

Application Deadline

Applications must be received or postmarked by **March 19, 2021**. **Confirmation of receipt will be sent via Email only. Incomplete applications and those postmarked after March 19, 2021 will not be considered.**

Notifications to Applicants and Scholarship Recipients ...

Applicants who are selected to receive a scholarship will be notified via email and/or first class mail. Upon notification, recipients are required to send their acceptance of the scholarship, provide a headshot photograph for publication, and confirm their participation in an awards recognition ceremony or event.

Applicants who are not selected will be notified by email only. The Scholarship is *not* renewable.

Application Instructions ...

Read the application carefully and complete all sections. **Applications that are incomplete or postmarked after the deadline of March 19, 2021 will not be considered for review or funding.**

- **Submit a single spaced, typewritten one page ESSAY (500 word limit) that addresses the following:**

How important is **community service**? (Please address this topic and include the following)

1. How has your participation in community service made an impact on your peers, at your school, or in your community?
2. How do you intend to continue serving your community in your college community?

What growth have you made academically throughout your high school experience?

***Essay - Undergraduate Soror Applicants ONLY*:**

1. What is your chapter currently doing to exemplify community service on campus and/or in the surrounding community?
2. How will this financial assistance help with the cost of schooling for this academic year?

- **Include TWO letters of recommendation on the official letterhead of the writer*:**

- **One and only one letter must** be from a high school teacher **or** counselor (not both), **and**
- **One letter** should be from a person who knows you in a professional or service capacity (such as an official of your church, **or** community service organization, **or** place of employment).

***Recommendations - Undergraduate Soror Applicants ONLY*:**

- **One** letter from a chapter official, **and**
- **One** letter from a person who knows you in a professional or service capacity (such as an official of your church, or community service organization, or place of employment).

Be sure to select writers of your recommendation who know you well, and can speak knowledgeably and passionately about your overall character, including: length of time they have known you, examples of your work ethic, leadership ability, and commitment to your goals.

- Instruct each writer to enclose their letter in a sealed envelope and to affix their name across the seal. Letters **must** be mailed with your application.
- Include an official **transcript** that includes course work from the 1st semester of the senior year. Transcript **must** contain the official seal of your high school. The sealed envelope **must** have the signature of the registrar affixed across the seal of the envelope, and be mailed **with** your application.
- Include **Letter(s) of Acceptance** for **Fall 2021** enrollment to all schools with “Confirmed” status on page 6 of the application.

***Transcript and Class Schedule (Proof of Enrollment) - Undergraduate Soror Applicants Only*:**

- Include an **official transcript**, which includes **current** quarter/semester of courses taken
- Include a schedule of classes for current quarter/semester or upcoming quarter/semester

- The completed and signed application packet (with **all** requested information) must be received or postmarked **on or before March 19, 2021**. Please include only **ONE** application per envelope.
